- The dental screening and health activities rendered at the school premises shall be honorary but referrals and specialty complex dental treatments at Al-Badar premises shall be done at discounted rates.




## This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU" is entered into at Gulbarga on the day of 1<sup>st</sup>Sept 2016

Between Al-Badar Rural Dental College & Hospital, Gulbarga (ARDCH) And Mother Theresa Charitable Hospital (MTCH) (50 Bedded Hospital)

## FOR ESTABLISHMENT / FUNCTIONING OF AL-BADAR SATELLITE DENTAL CLINIC.

With the following terms and conditions detailed below:


- 1. Al-Badar Rural Dental College & Hospital, Gulbarga has put up a Satellite Clinic at Mother Theresa Hospital with one Dental Chair and will take the responsibility of maintaining the required equipment and the furniture. However MTCH will provide Attender Assistance.
- 2. ARDCH will provide all the instruments required for OPD services and operative procedures.
- 3. The ARDCH will post the duty doctors, MTCH will provide Attender Assistance. The timings are specified and regularity of the duty doctor is assured to avoid inconveniences to the patients.
- 4. Mother Theresa Hospital will provide operation theatre facilities to ARDCH for operating Maxillofacial Cases and the OT cost will be borne by the patient party. ARDCH will consult the administration / OT person incharge of MTCH before fixing the timing of the Surgery. So that the OT is free and available.



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- 5. The camp & treatment will begin in Mother Theresa Hospital, Uploan, (Kapnoor Post, Humnabad Road) and camps at surrounding villages will commence at sharp 9:30AM. For village camps Dental Mobile Van will reach MTCH from there to the designated village from 9:30AM onwards.
- 6. If any blood and Urine investigation has to be done the same should be done in MTCH clinical Laboratory.
- 7. Mother Theresa Hospital will provide a Para Medical staff only during the surgeries, in consultation with the person incharge for the staff/ person incharge of the OT. MTCH will also provide the Anesthesia services when required through on call of the anesthetist. The anesthetist's charges and the anesthesia drugs cost will be borne by the patient.
- 8. The Maxillofacial Surgeon's of ARDCH will perfrom the surgery without any operative charges. However, MTCH will charge the `OT charges as per the case and the Surgery.
- Mother Theresa Hospital will provide the Ambulance services only to the patients if necessary from MTCH to ARDCH (Institution to Institution)
- 10. In satellite clinic treatments such as complete dentures, removable partial dentures, temporary fillings, extraction and scaling will be done free of cost. Other treatment will be done at concessional rates.
- 11.MTCH expects the staff of ARDCH to co-operate and collaborate in the functioning of satellite clinic.
- 12.If the ARDCH staff face any problem / difficulty will report to Director/ Administrator of MTCH to solve the same and not to any other staff of MTCH.
- 13.ARDCH will not have any interference concerning the administration and management policies of MTCH.
- 14.Any other matter other than what is mentioned in the MOU arises, the decision makers of both ARDCH and MTCH could sit and discuss and come to a consensus.
- 15.In case of any dispute or difference between the parties, the same shall be resolved amicably by the decision makers of ARDCH and MTCH to the MOU.
- 16. This MOU will bind for 5 years from the date of signature unless it is renewed before the expiry of the date.



Suppression of the inflammatory response by curcumin as discussed in the preclinical studies involves the inhibition of the induction of COX-1, COX-2, iNOS, and production of cytokines such as interferon-y. been shown to scavenge O, and OH radicals showing curcumin can have both pro-oxidant or anti-oxidant effects depending on the doses and the chemical environment (e.g., availability of free Cu2+ ions). 

ABSTRACT: Introduction: Oral submucous fibrosis (OSMF) is a potentially malignant disorder carrying a high risk of malignant transformation. A wide range of treatment modalities have been proposed for OSMF but none have proved curative or reduced the morbidity significantly. In-vitro and in-vivo studies suggested curcumin as an anticancer, antioxidant and anti-inflammatory agent. Thus based on this literature survey the study was undertaken. Aim: To evaluate the efficacy of curcumin for the treatment of clinical stage 2 OSMF patients and to compare it with patients receiving placebo drugs. Study Design and Sample Size: A randomized single blinded placebo controlled clinical trial was conducted in 100 clinical stage 2 OSMF patients with clinically and histopathologically confirmed diagnosis. Materials and Methods: 100 clinical stage 2 patients selected for the study were divided into 2 groups with 50 patients each. Group 1 patients were given placebo capsules. Group 2 patients were given curcumin capsules of 500 mg. The primary outcome measures were to note the subjective symptoms and objective parameters. These parameters were analyzed at baseline and 6th month. Patients were also evaluated histopathologically after 6 months. ANOVA, students t test and p value were utilized for statistical inferences. Results: Patients in group 2 showed statistically significant improvement in all the subjective signs and symptoms and histopathological changes with p value of < 0.001 when compared with group 1 patients. Conclusion: It is evident from the study that curcumin holds good promise in the treatment of OSMF.

INTRODUCTION: OSMF was first described by Schwartz in 1952 as a fibrosing condition in five Indian women and in Kenya and he called it as atrophica idiopathica tropica



Subsequently Joshi in 1953 is credited to have coined the term Oral submucous fibrosis. Epidemiological studies show a unique prevalence of this premalignant condition in India and South East Asia 1. It has a specific geographic distribution and predominantly affects the Asians 2. Pindburg has summed up the clinical and histopathological features in his definition for OSMF as "an insidious chronic disease affecting oral mucosa or any part of the oral cavity and occasionally extending into pharynx and Esophagus, although occasionally

ABRDCH shall have the right to terminate the agreement with ZES, in case ZES either fails to provide the services successfully as mentioned in the agreement, or violates any of the clause mentioned in the MOU, or exploits the students or misuses the partnership with ABRDCH in any way.

# h) Amendment to the Agreement

The obligation of ZES and ABRDCH have been outlined in this agreement. However, during the operation of the agreement, circumstances may arise which call for alteration or modifications of this Agreement. These modifications/alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.

## i) Period of Validity

This agreement shall be valid for two years from the date of signing the agreement and to be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both the parties.

## j) Arbitration

Any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this Agreement shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the Agreement.
