

Evaluation Efficacy of Adhathoda vasica leaf extract mouth rinse in reducing aerosol contamination produced by ultrasonic scaler-A clinicomicrobiological study

A Split mouth Study was conducted to evaluate Efficacy of Adhathoda vasica leaf extract mouth rinse in reducing aerosol contamination, produced by ultrasonic scaler. 15 subjects were selected randomly. Left side mouth was considered as group I (without mouthwash) and scaling was carried out without pre rinsing and aerosol was collected. Contralateral side of mouth was considered as group II wherein scaling was performed with pre rinsing using Adhathoda vasica leaf extract mouth rinse with for 1 min. During scaling and root planning, aerosol was collected on 5% blood agar plates. Blood agar plates were incubated at 37°C for 48hours, and colonies of bacteria were counted using classical bacterial counting technique and they were expressed as a number of CFUs (colony forming units) seen on agar plates. The study concluded that Adhathoda vasica leaf extract mouth rinse mouthrinse can be used as an alternative for short term maintenance therapy and has an advantage of not having any side effects but has antimicrobial property for the reduction of aerosols which is produced by ultrasonic scaler.
