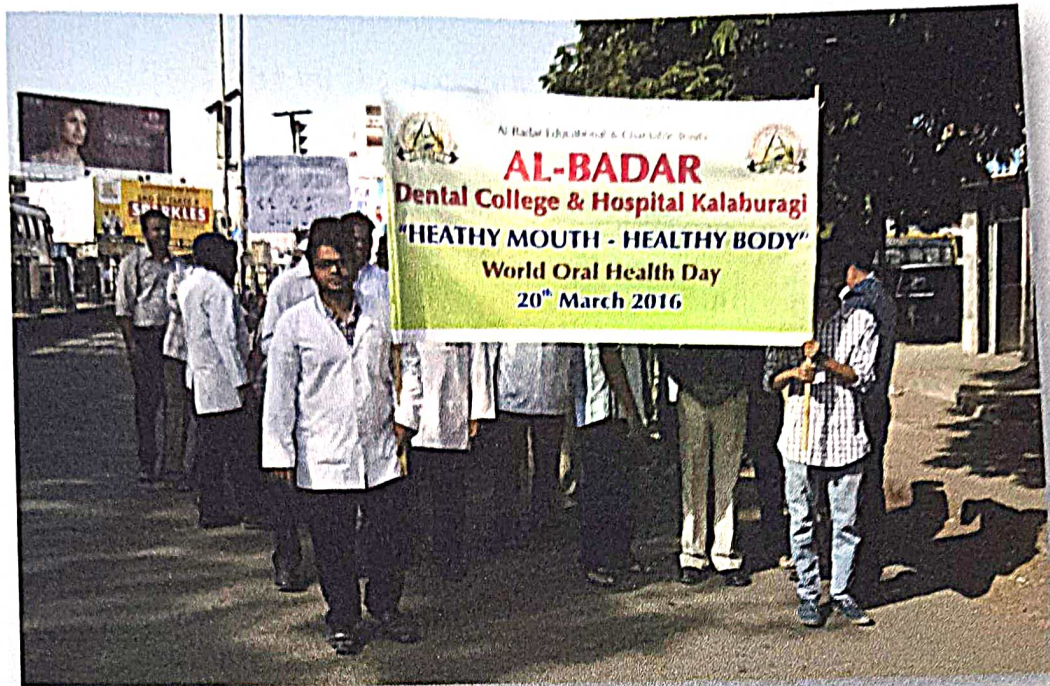

Both webinars were followed by Question and Answer session.

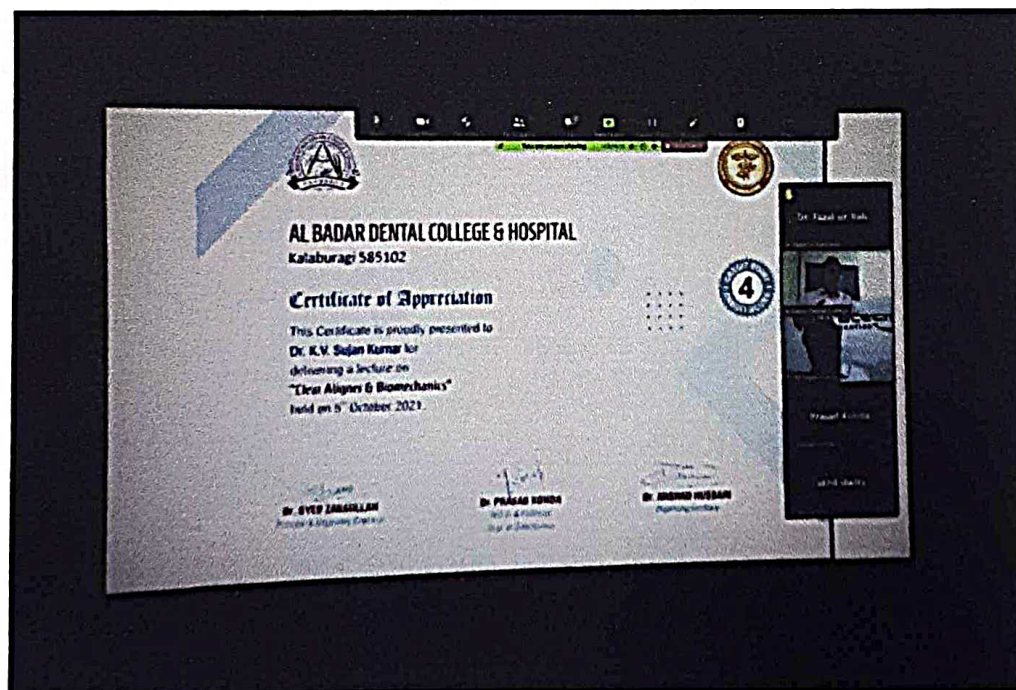

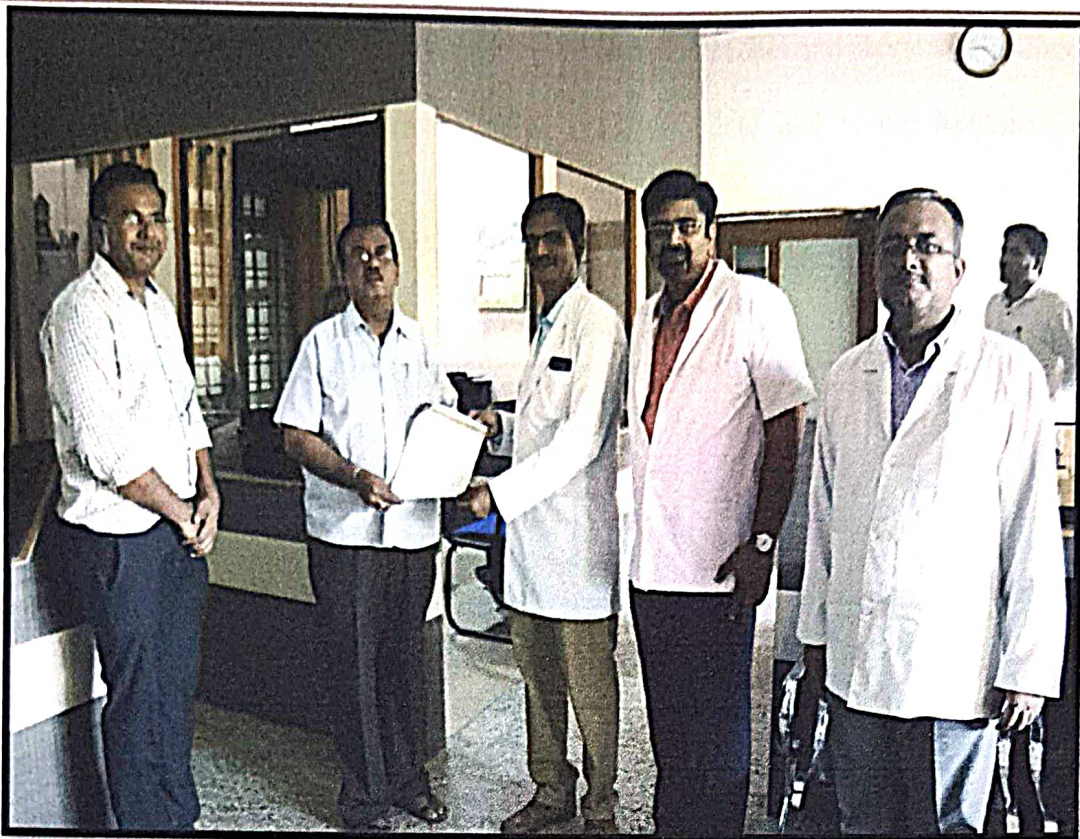


Figure 4: Handing over memorandum to authority





The patients that we screened were all the attenders and drivers & sweepers of ARDCH with tobacco habits (smoke & smokeless form).




NATIONAL ORAL PATHOLOGISTS' DAY (2020)
