



7.3 Institutional Distinctiveness

Response:

The Institution was founded with the principle of benefiting humanity, and from the outset, it has focused on serving the people of the Kalyan Karnataka Area.

Despite significant advancements in the healthcare sector, our rural and suburban regions continue to be underserved in terms of healthcare services. A large portion of this population still does not seek treatment for oral and facial diseases due to limited awareness about oral health issues or inadequate access to timely medical care. Financial constraints also play a crucial role, particularly among the economically disadvantaged communities, where affordability remains a significant barrier to accessing dental treatment and overall oral healthcare services.

Our institute has conducted numerous events such as camps, lectures, rallies, and skits aimed at raising awareness in both urban and rural communities about oral health care and treatment, cancer awareness, and the dangers of tobacco, along with measures to prevent its use. Our Institute is trying its best to provide treatment of oral diseases, disorders, trauma and aesthetic treatment to the community. A bus facility is provided for patients also.

Our institute has organized many camps and programs like lectures, rallies, skits to bring awareness among the community about oral health care and treatment, cancer awareness, hazards of tobacco and prevention of its use in city as well as rural areas.

71 camps have been conducted with screening of 8919 patients, following visit of these patients to the hospital for further treatment. Patients seeking care for prevention and management of basic and advanced dental ailments. Routine dental procedures are performed with on par excellence. A variety of special cases were treated in various specialties. A total of 704 special cases were treated with advanced techniques in our institute.

In oral surgery department special cases like 3 TMJ surgeries were performed, 41 trauma cases, 10 oral submucous fibrosis cases, 13 cystic lesions and 8 carcinomas were treated successfully. Root canal therapies are done with the state of art equipment like Endodontic surgical microscope. 66 Special cases were treated like midline diastema closure, fractured tooth attachment, vital and non-vital bleaching etc. in the department of endodontics and conservative dentistry.

To aid the final diagnosis of the disease the department of Oral Pathology and Microbiology has embraced advanced techniques like Immuno-histochemistry which aids in adequate and appropriate management of maxillofacial pathologies. Prompt services are provided by this department for evaluating safe margins during Onco- surgical procedures. 41 Histopathology cases were reported like fibroma, mucocoele, radicular cyst, dermoid cyst etc. and 31 special cases were reported like lichen planus, Dermoid cyst, odontogenic keratocyst etc. in the department of oral pathology.

Orthodontic treatment procedures which include fixed functional appliances, orthopedic arch expansion, zygomatic screw placements for impaction of maxillary arch and current techniques like self-ligating, clear aligners and Pits are also practiced. 8 special cases were done like IZC etc. 5 Ortho-Perio interdisciplinary cases were also done. 45 Dental implants were being made affordable to the masses and are undertaken as a routine procedure in the prosthodontic department. 70 special cases were done including 2 implant supported dentures, 4 denture relining cases, 14 single dentures, 1 tooth supported denture, 2 post and core cases and 1 cheek bumper was done.

94 special cases were done including implants, frenectomy, mucogingival surgeries vestibuloplasty, coronoplasty, laser assisted flap surgeries, laser assisted various procedures were done in the department of Periodontics. 275 special cases were done like TMJ disorders, Orofacial pain and autonomous disorders etc. in the department of oral medicine and radiology.

The college is in the process of adding one more feather to its crown by adding 100 bedded multi-specialty hospital to serve society round the clock with more advanced health care services.
