Functions

- c) Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required

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knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process;

- d) Collection and analysis of feedback from all stakeholders on qualityrelated institutional processes;
- e) Dissemination of information on various quality parameters to all stakeholders;
- f) Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
- g) Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement; g) Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices;
