1. Health & Disease: Concepts, Philosophy, Definition & Characteristics

Earlier health was assumed as absence of disease, however in recent times; now scientifically it is viewed as the state of physical mental and social wellbeing apart from the absence of disease or any infirmity.

2. Public Health: Definition & Concepts, History of Public Health

Introduction:

Public health, the art and science of preventing disease, prolonging life, and promoting physical and mental health, sanitation, personal hygiene, control of infectious diseases, and organization of health services. From the normal human interactions involved in resolving social issues, new way emerged in recognition of the importance of community action in the promotion of health and the prevention and treatment of disease, and this is expressed in the concept of public health.

3. General Epidemiology: Definition, Objectives, Methods

Introduction:

Epidemiology is "the study of the distribution and determinants of health-related states or events in specified populations, and the application of this study to the prevention and control of health problems". Epidemiology use models to explain the occurrence of disease, susceptibility and exposure or risk factors. The epidemiologic triad (or epidemiologic triangle), views the occurrence of disease as the balance of host, agent, and environment factors.

4. Environment Health: Concepts, Principles, Protection, Sources, Purification, Environmental sanitation, Disposal of waste.

Introduction:

Environmental Health focuses on the interrelationships between people and their environment, promotes human health and well-being, and fosters healthy and safe communities. As a fundamental component of a comprehensive public health system, environmental health works to advance policies and programs to reduce chemical and other environmental exposures in air, water, soil and food to protect residents and provide communities with healthier environments.

5. Health Education: Definition, Concepts, Principles, methods, Health Education Aids

Introduction:

Health education is the principle by which individuals and groups of people learn to behave in a manner conducive to the promotion, maintenance, or restoration of health. Health education provides learning experiences on health topics. Health education strategies are tailored for the target population using appropriate methods and educational aids. Health education provides information on particular health topics, including the health benefits/threats they face, and provides tools to build capacity and support behavior change in an appropriate setting.

6. Public Health Administration: Priority, Establishment, manpower, private practice management, hospital management.

Introduction:

Public health administration is the integral part of public health that deals with the administration, leadership, and management of health care systems, such as hospitals, networks, and public health systems.

7. Ethics and Jurisprudence: Professional liabilities, negligence, malpractice, consents, evidence, contracts, methods of identification in forensic dentistry.

Introduction:

Ethics is a science of ideal human character and behavior in situations where the distinction should be made between what is right and wrong. Ethics are an unwritten code of conduct that encompasses both professional conduct and judgment. Dental ethics deals with moral duties and obligations of the dentist towards his patients, professional colleagues and to the society. Dental jurisprudence is a set of legal regulations set forth by each state's legislature describing the legal limitations and regulations related to the practice of dentistry.

8. Behavioral sciences: Definition of sociology, anthropology and psychology and their role in dental practice and community.

Introduction:

Behavioral sciences is a discipline deals with the subject of human actions, usually including the fields of sociology, social and cultural anthropology, psychology, behavioral aspects of biology, economics, geography, law, psychiatry and political science. The knowledge of behavioral sciences is necessary and relevant in creating a successful dental practice, benefitting patients and dental professionals. In order to treat patients successfully, dental professionals must understand and change or modify patient behavior.

9. Health Care Delivery System: Center and state, oral Health Policy, primary health care, national programmes, health organization

Introduction:

A health care delivery system is an organization of people, institutions, and resources to deliver health care services to meet the health needs of the population. Health care is the prevention, treatment, and management of illness and the preservation of mental and physical well being through the services offered by the medical, nursing, and allied health professions. There are 3 different levels of health care systems which are primary, secondary and tertiary.

10. Dentist Act: 1948 with amendments, Dental councils composition and responsibilities


Introduction:

The Dentist Act, 1948, that extends to the whole of India, is an Act to regulate the profession of dentistry; which was passed by the Indian Parliament in close association with All India Dental Association on 29th March, 1948. In this Act, there are five chapters, namely, Introduction, Dental Council of India, State Dental Councils, Registration and Miscellaneous with a total of 55 Sections
